# **Background to activity**

Children will take part in a quick quiz to introduce them to a variety of carnivores.

#### Materials needed

- Pens and paper
- Leader's 'Who am I' Q&A sheet

#### Running the activity

Children can take part in the quiz individually or in groups. The teacher/leader reads out the description of each animal after which the children must write down the name of the animal they think it is.
