**Once a common sight in Britain,
hazel dormice are now extinct
in many counties.**

PTES is reversing this decline.

Dormice are a protected species in Britain and regarded a priority for conservation action. We're helping dormice by:

- ▶ keeping a close eye on how they're doing through our monitoring scheme. Records collected by hundreds of volunteer monitors provide the insight needed to guide our actions to save dormice
- ▶ reintroducing hundreds of dormice where they've gone extinct and regularly checking how they are doing
- ▶ providing training and guides for woodland managers because it's so important to manage woodlands and hedgerows sensitively.

Why are dormice declining?


Dormice are good indicators of animal and plant diversity and dormouse-friendly habitats are also good for woodland birds, bats and butterflies. They need well-managed woodlands connected by hedgerows so that they can spread. They thrived when hazel trees in woodlands were regularly cut back (coppiced) because this provided plenty of dormouse-friendly food and a place for them to live. Despite the revival of coppicing in some areas, many woodlands have changed too drastically to support dormice. The loss of two thirds of our hedgerows, and the lack of suitable management of many that remain, makes matters worse. **Dormice still hanging on have limited living space and are increasingly isolated.**
