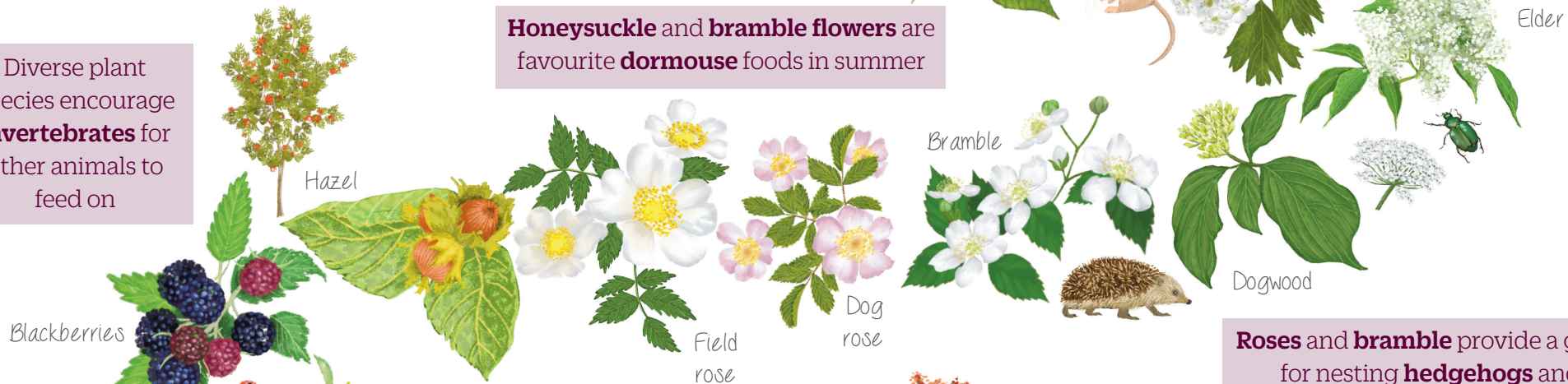
Nectar-rich plants in early spring feed emerging **insects**



Deadwood-dependent **insects** feed on flowers such as **hawthorn, elder** or **hogweed** as adults

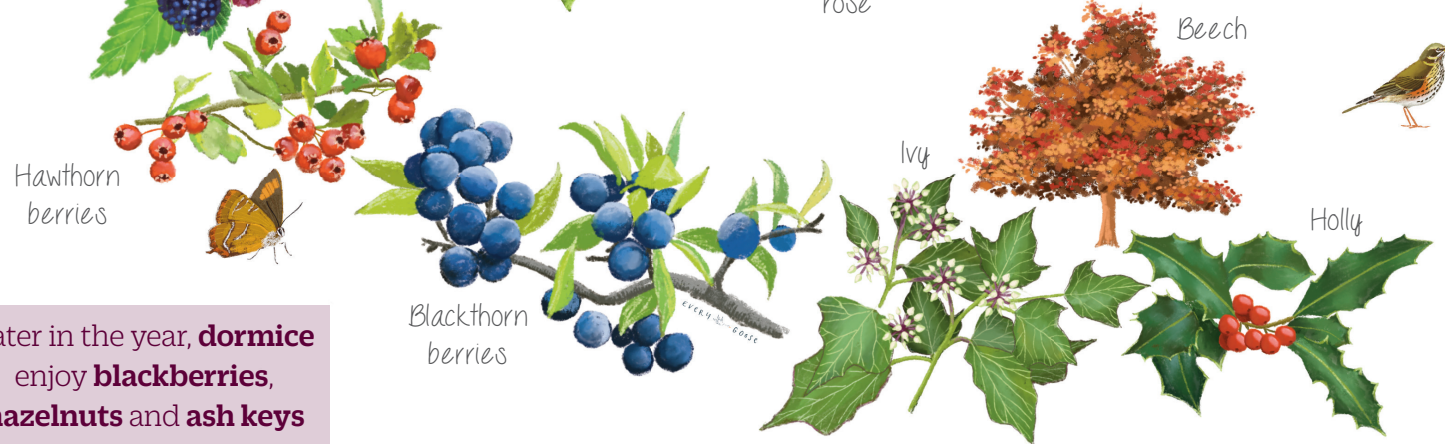
Honeysuckle and **bramble** flowers are favourite **dormouse** foods in summer

Diverse plant species encourage **invertebrates** for other animals to feed on



Roses and **bramble** provide a good structure for nesting **hedgehogs** and **dormice**

Later in the year, **dormice** enjoy **blackberries, hazelnuts** and **ash keys**



Flowering **ivy** is one of the last plants supplying nectar in autumn

Berries ripening in succession, such as **hawthorn, dog rose** and **holly**, provide food for **birds** and **mammals** over autumn and winter
